

Subsidy and Fee's

Subsidy is a funding option that is available through Southwest Alberta Child and Family Services Authority. It applies to parents who are within a certain income level... Applications are available at the centre!!

Fee's

Infants (0-18 months)

100-150 Hours- \$600
150.25-200 Hours- \$650

Toddlers and Preschoolers

100-150 Hours - \$550
150.25-200 Hours - \$610

Part Time Fees:

\$6.25/hours until full time fee is reached.

A discount of 15% off is given on the second child in care. Subsidy does not qualify for this discount.

Subsidy Rates

Preschool Subsidy \$615
Infant Subsidy \$697

Minimum parent portion \$115

E.C.S. \$375/ Month (10 School Months)
Children over 100 hours will pay regular fees.

Social Development: Children's social development is encouraged through daily activities that promote the enhancement of social skills. The children can will be interacting and forming relationships with the other children and staff.

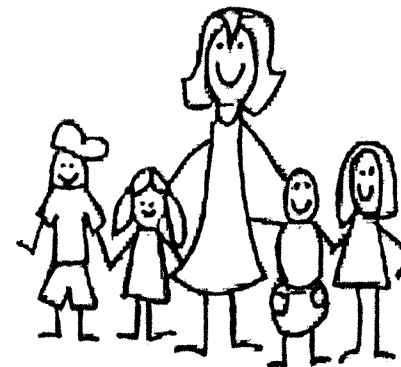

Philosophy

The philosophy of the Taber Child Care Centre is based on the following principles:

- ★ Children learn through play
- ★ The program is child oriented
- ★ The children have the opportunity for choice.

In order to meet the needs of the children we will:

- ★ Provide activity centres which are interesting, child accessible and are geared for all ages of children.
- ★ Ensure that children have a choice in activities.
- ★ Provide a balance between quiet and active play (group v.s individual play)
- ★ Provide opportunities for fun
- ★ Work with agencies to meet the needs of families.
- ★ Maintain and post licensing and health inspection reports for all parents and visitors to see.
- ★ Maintain licensed capacities in order to ensure adequate staff to child ratio's
- ★ Provide resources to the families.

Qualified Staff

It is required by the Taber Child Care Centre that all staff receive a child development certificate within 6 months of employment, a valid first aid in child care must be obtained in this time as well. Criminal record checks are mandatory upon employment and maintained throughout a staff members time at the centre.

Play Centres

The Taber Child Care Centre is made up of both outdoor and indoor play spaces. These spaces are then broken up into areas that are set for play daily and changed on a weekly basis by the child care centre staff.

These play centres are based on the interests and ideas of the children and are set up with materials that are appropriate for their developmental stage.
