Purpose

The purpose is to develop operating guidelines for the Fire Department Uniform Policy.

Operating Guidelines

- 1) All uniformed staff will be required to have and maintain, in good repair, all uniform items issued to them.
- 2) In the event any item of issued clothing is either lost or damaged beyond use, the firefighter will notify the Fire Chief who can decide on the replacement of the clothing item.
- 3) When working at the station or when dealing with any members of the public, members shall wear their issued uniform with shoulder flashes and appropriate rank markings.
Exceptions are:
 - A response requires PPE that exceeds station uniform.
 - Hard work in a hot environment precludes wearing a uniform shirt.
 - When the Fire Chief or Designate deems it appropriate.
