

TOWN OF TABER
BY-LAW NO. A - 275

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF TABER, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA,
TO ESTABLISH FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE USE, SALE,
DISCHARGE, OF, FIREWORKS OR SHOP GOODS

WHEREAS Section 158 and 159 of The Municipal Government Act, being the Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980, Chapter M-26, provides that Council may by By-Law introduce regulations for the prevention or the extinguishing of fires and for the preservation of life and property from injury or destruction.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Taber, in the Province of Alberta, deem it proper and expedient to initiate fees for the issuance of permits for the sale and use of fireworks within the corporate limits of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Alberta Fire Code Regulations M 35/86 provide for certain restrictions as it applies to the utilization of fireworks.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Taber, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:

I PERMITS - Shall be required for the sale, and discharging of fireworks as follows:

(1) Permit for the sale of fireworks.

A person upon written application accompanied by an application fee of \$75.00, may receive a permit from the Fire Chief to sell fireworks.

No permit shall be issued for the sale of fireworks until the Fire Chief is satisfied that a business license has been acquired by the applicant.

(2) A Permit to Discharge

a) An application for a person or corporation to discharge fireworks within the corporate limits of the Municipality shall be assessed a permit fee of \$100.00 for each occasion.

In addition to the fee the Fire Chief shall ensure that the applicant has a minimum of \$500,000.00 comprehensive liability insurance.

c) In addition to the above, the Fire Chief may set out terms and conditions as may be applicable in the Fire Code, Fire Prevention Act, or regulations associated thereto.

III The permit fees applicable in this By-Law shall not apply to any firm, corporation, or society which is non-profit orientated and has met the approval of the Fire Chief.

IV This By-Law shall not apply to the sale of items known as "sparklers" for decoration purposes, or "caps" for cap guns, provided the person acquiring same is 18 years of age or older.

The Fire Chief may, in writing, exempt other materials of a similar nature, giving consideration to the protection of persons and property.

V APPEALS

Where a person feels aggrieved by the decision of the Fire Chief on the terms and conditions of the permit, or the refusal of permit, he may appeal to the Council of the Town of Taber accordingly.

VI PENALTIES

Any person who contravenes the provisions of this By-Law shall be liable for a penalty of:


- a) First Offence - minimum fine of \$250.00 and a maximum fine of \$1,000.00;
- b) Second or Subsequent Offence - a minimum fine of \$1,000.00 and a maximum fine of \$2,500.00.

VII This By-Law shall take force and effect upon the final reading thereof.


