## **TABER BACKYARD BBQ COMPETITION**

### **Rules and Regulations**

1. Contest is open to the public for anyone 12 and under
2. Set up will be from 12:30pm – 1:30pm the afternoon of the competition. All teams must be set up by 1:30pm. It is your team's choice what time to start, you are welcome to begin as soon as you choose once set up.
3. Each team will consist of a head chef and as many assistants as the chef cook deems necessary.
4. Each chef must be accompanied by an adult or guardian over the age of 18.
5. All seasoning and cooking of product shall be done within the confines of the team's assigned cooking space.
6. Each contestant shall supply all his/her own cooking ingredients, cooking devices, utensils and prep tables. Some electrical will be available, please book ahead of time if required.
7. The Town will provide the BBQ, a table, the hot dogs & the buns. Teams must use the provided space/ equipment.
8. Team are responsible to cook two identical hotdogs. Serving ½ a hot dog to each judge.
9. Fires may not be built on the ground.
10. Fresh water points will be available on the grounds.
11. No live animals are allowed in the cooking area.
12. Cleanliness of the cook, assistant cooks and contest area is required. Sanitation of work area should be implemented. Guardians must ensure that kids maintain cleanliness.
13. Judging will begin at 2:00 pm. The allowable turn-in time will be five minutes before to five minutes after the posted time, with no exceptions.
14. Entries will be submitted in the numbered container supplied by the contest organizer.
15. Each contestant must submit at least four half-hot dogs separated and in a container.
16. Entries are scored based on APPEARANCE AND TASTE. Taste score is doubled. The lowest score will be dropped, but will be used to break a tie. The scoring system is from 9 (excellent), 5 (average) to 1 (bad).

17. Marking of any kind of the meat or container will result in a disqualification. This includes, but is not limited to painting, sculpting or decorating. No aluminum foil or stuffing is allowed in the container. No toothpicks or foreign material is permitted.
18. Awards will take place at 3:00 pm at the stage. There will be first, second and third place winners.
19. After the competition teams are responsible for clean-up of their area immediately following the contest.
