



address numbers

Checklist for Homes & Businesses

FRONT OF PROPERTY

- Numbers face the street/road
- Numbers are plainly visible from the road
- Attached to building **OR** placed on a sign near entrance
- Numbers are at least 6 inches tall
- Numbers' colours don't blend in (colour contrasts against the property)
- Numbers are numerical, not words (ie: 4900, not "Four Thousand Nine Hundred")

More than one unit in the structure?

- Address number assigned to each unit is displayed on or beside the front door to each unit (ie: Apartment #7 or Unit A)

BACK OF PROPERTY

(ONLY IF YOUR PROPERTY ABUTS A LANE/ALLEY)

- Numbers face the lane/alley
- Numbers are clearly visible from the alley
- Numbers are not blocked by trees, landscaping, fences, etc.
- Numbers are reflective (BACK NUMBERS ONLY)
This is so the numbers can be seen at night if a light is shone on them
Hardware or dollar store numbers are usually reflective
- Back numbers at least 4 inches tall
