Purpose

This policy establishes a Traffic Committee and the function of that committee.

Policy Statement

- 1) Traffic safety in the Town of Taber relies on the principles of education, engineering and enforcement. The Municipal Government Act (RSA) empowers the municipality to delegate authority and establish traffic rules to enhance safety and accommodate the unique needs of individual communities when such rules are not in conflict with the established area of responsibility laid out in the Traffic Safety Act and associated traffic regulations. The Town of Taber has a Traffic Control Bylaw (22-2021) which establishes such rules as deemed necessary and that the MGA delegated authority rests with Council for approval of all permanent traffic control devices and the CAO for all other measures.
- 2) The Taber Traffic Committee shall be the manner in which such rules are established.
- 3) The Taber Traffic Committee shall be comprised of a Member of Council, the CAO and a representative from each of the Engineering and Public Works Department and the Police Service. The Traffic Committee may from time to time include such persons who may provide expertise or input at the request of the Committee.
- 4) Administration shall establish procedures for this policy and shall be responsible to ensure the spirit and intent of the policy is adhered to.
